Be on guard. Stand firm_in the faith. Be courageous. Be strong. And do everything with love. 1 Corinthians 16:13-14



Lacking Love Demonstrates a <u>LEGALISTIC</u> View of God's Expectations

If I could speak all the languages of earth and of angels, but <u>didn't love</u> others, I would only be a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. If I had the gift of prophecy, and if I understood all of God's secret plans and possessed all knowledge, and if I had such faith that I could move mountains, but <u>didn't love</u> others, I would be nothing. If I gave everything I have to the poor and even sacrificed my body, I could boast about it; but if I <u>didn't love</u> others, I would have gained nothing. <u>Love</u> is patient and kind. <u>Love</u> is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. <u>Love</u> never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance. 1 Corinthians 13:1-7

Love Makes the Message RING True or False

Love is Shown in **SACRIFICE**

This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. There is no greater love than to <u>lay down</u> one's <u>life</u> for one's friends. John 15:12-13

Living Out Our Love

Our Love Should be GENUINE and ACTIVE

Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions. 1 John 3:18

Our Love Should be MOTIVATED by God's Love for US

Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for <u>love comes from God</u>. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love. God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is <u>real love</u>—not that we loved God, but that <u>he loved us</u> and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.
